

BEYOND BORING BORDERS WORKSHOP

Supply List

The purpose of this workshop is to explore the wide variety of borders that can enhance your quilt. Borders are the hidden factor in creating a pleasing quilt.

This Class is very different from most workshops. A Border Workbook (Colored Border Binder is \$20) is used and we will go page by page learning the techniques needed to make each border. Included are how to figure the correct size, design, and color choices for a quilt. The second half is focused on looking at quilt tops that the students have bought in so as a class we can see how to pick the correct border.

Students are also encouraged to bring quilt tops that need borders so that the class can discuss various options.

Sewing will then begin if time permits (sometimes the above takes the whole time)

Bringing the below supplies is optional.

**If time permits the students then work on their own borders or complete the workbook trying the many new borders. This can be done by using a "Cheater Square", or any Completed block or UFO square or small quilt. For class purposes a smaller center (12" - 24") is ideal. Picking a design from the book and adding borders will be the focus of the second part of the workshop.

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

If you wish to complete the workbook with samples of the various borders – just bring fabric scraps to work with so you can try the many new techniques

FABRIC

- A "Center" Square ("Cheater Block, Small Quilt or anything you wish to add a border to)
- B. Fabric for border design - can be some to match what was used in the center but bring a large variety of fabrics.

SEWING SUPPLIES:

- A. Sewing Machine
- B. Normal Supplies (i.e. rotary cutter, rulers, thread, etc)
- C. Triangle Squares Paper if you have them can be helpful NOT NECESSARY
